Seventy. That is the number I will report to you this week. It represents the number of degrees above zero on the Fahrenheit scale the air was surrounding the meadow on the east side of the Gallatin River at the foot of Sheep Rock this past Sunday afternoon. Seventy was also the number of people that gathered in that meadow to celebrate the resurrection of Jesus.

This Easter gathering was the first time in over a year we have officially met as a congregation. Oh sure there had previously been occasions where we may have bumped into one another, seen each other in the flesh, heard one another's voices unfiltered by the internet, but this was the first time it was sort of like good old, regular church.

It still wasn't quite the same because we all sat at a distance from each other and we all wore masks. But it was the same, because people introduced guests they brought, and there was laughter, and there were young people running around.

It wasn't quite the same because we were in the meadow and not in the chapel so we were at the mercy of the wind (and although it wasn't blowing seventy miles per hour, there were gusts that may have been half that.) But it was the same because every time I looked up at Sheep Rock I was overwhelmed with its majesty and made myself more than a little dizzy.

It wasn't quite the same because the music was prerecorded and played over a speaker system. But it was the same because the Alleluias we sang from Jesus Christ Is Risen Today were just as familiar.



It is not the only thing we share in common. In his first attempt to win the governorship back in 2016, he and his wife visited our church one Sunday. It was communion Sunday and I served the cup of salvation to the governor.

I look forward to the day when we can all taste the bread and the cup of our Lord in communion with one another. The thought makes me tremble.
