Pandemic Response Team Report by John Patterson

It was uplifting, as always, to worship together last Sunday. Young Andrew Driscoll's solo piece on cello was quite a hit. Thanks, and congratulations, Andrew!

Your Pandemic Response Team continues to meet by Zoom weekly on Mondays at 4:00. You are encouraged to join us anytime -or- to let us know if you have something you would like us to discuss. We serve under the direction of Session and for the whole congregation.

The 7-day rolling average of Covid-19 cases here in Gallatin County was 43.6/100,000 people last Thursday. Although that number of cases still precludes us from resuming in-person services we are optimistic about the increased availability of the Covid-19 vaccines, anticipating that the number of cases should start to significantly decline soon. We encourage you, and hope you encourage others, to receive the vaccines as soon as you can to protect yourselves and others. We're all in this together!

After more than a year, our church's Boy Scout Troup has resumed Tuesday evening meetings in the Fellowship Hall/Library and in Rooms 102-104, following our church Covid-19 Guidelines.

For those using the church building, we've discontinued use of the "sign in and out" procedure This decision was based on the CDC report confirming that Covid-19 is almost completely transmitted by air. With this information, it becomes less important to know where people have been in the building since the need to clean surfaces is no greater during this pandemic than it was before. The "sign in and out" procedure was also designed for contact tracing should someone develop Covid-19. At this point we believe that anyone diagnosed with Covid-19 should be able to list for contact tracing those who they might have exposed.

A task group is continuing work to optimize our hybrid worship and hybrid meeting experiences. Some new equipment will be needed. Having been considered for years, they are looking at how to optimally use AV screens in the sanctuary and they are considering the portable technology needed for hybrid meetings using Zoom in places like Rooms 203-204 or the Fellowship Hall. It's all exciting!

Remaining connected as a church family remains so important. Continue to reach out to one another in whatever ways you can. For those who have been completely vaccinated, the CDC tells us it's OK to start meeting again in small groups. And, even with those who have not yet been vaccinated, consider meeting in small groups outside, like we did last Fall. See page 2 for Zoom meeting instructions.
