Dear Beloved Ones,

Every time we gather to hear God's Word, we can trust that peace will underlie every message from God. Sometimes the message includes warning or a call to justice-making, but God's purpose is always shalom, right relations between God and the world and between the world's inhabitants. Peace on earth, good will to all! The Christmas angels' message is God's eternal Word.

This Sunday we will begin hearing God's word of peace contained in the letter to the Ephesians. With county health continuing at a moderate-low level of risk for unvaccinated persons, we are not limiting attendance numbers, nor are we requiring masks or social distancing. We are also singing our praises. There is a section of the sanctuary reserved for those who desire to be distanced from others. Those who are not vaccinated or who are immunocompromised are advised to continue exercising caution in any public setting, and we continue to offer online worship, simultaneous with our 9:30 am in-person service. At this time, nursery care is not available. Children are welcome, as always, to sit with their families in the sanctuary. We have discontinued use of a reservation system.

Please note that we will hold outdoor services at Rockhaven twice in July, on July 18 and July 25.

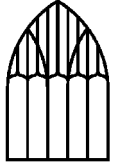
